Would you like to take your Patrol Camp Permit or Senior Section Permit?

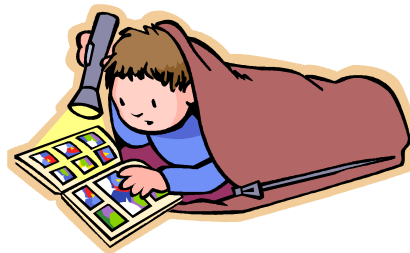
Then come to the County Residential Training, next year being held at Faurefold, Lince Lane, Westcott on Saturday 2 March 2019.

- Please ensure your Bank Details and Levy Information for 2019 have been added by noon on the 18 January 2019.
- You will need the following information to hand to add your level's subscription details:
 - a. To work out the levy amount:
District + Division + County + Country/Region = Total amount (£) per member in your area.
 - b. The levy amount you wish to charge in your level only (per member)
 - c. The level's account name, 8 digit account number and 6 digit sort code
 - d. If it's a building society, the building society reference number (Please also check with your building society the correct account details needed to receive bank transfer payments).
 - e. To add these details to the subscription system please click on the 'Manage Bank Details' tab from the left hand menu, select 'Edit' to add or change your level's subscription details.
- All areas are responsible for their own levy information.
- Once the 18th January deadline has passed NO Levy Amounts can be entered or changed.
- Trial invoices will be available from noon on Tuesday 29 January 2019 until 7pm on Monday 25 February 2019. During this four week trial invoice period all levels should ensure that the membership records on GO are up to date so that the Official payable invoice is correct.

Level 3 safe space with Level 2 conversation:

Level 3 training session - for any member leading a team of adults, leaders in charge (or at least one leader per unit with module four of the Leadership qualification), mentors, advisers, coordinators (except GO coordinators), licence holders on residentials, trainers, tutors and those who need to complete Level 4.

Leaders requiring this training must complete the online module [HERE](#) or Level 3 before attending a training session - please bring along your online module certificate.

Level 2 follow -on conversations - Leaders who have completed the online Level 2 safe space module require a follow- on conversation. [HERE](#)

We will be holding a drop in session at the start of the training above for any leader who requires this conversation - again please bring your online module certificate.

How many of our girls (or leaders) know that they live in or very near an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty? The Surrey Hills have become better known since those cyclists pounded through as part of the Olympics in 2012 but not everyone realises that it is a protected area because of its beauty. No more information here because you and the members of your unit can learn all about it by doing the badge.

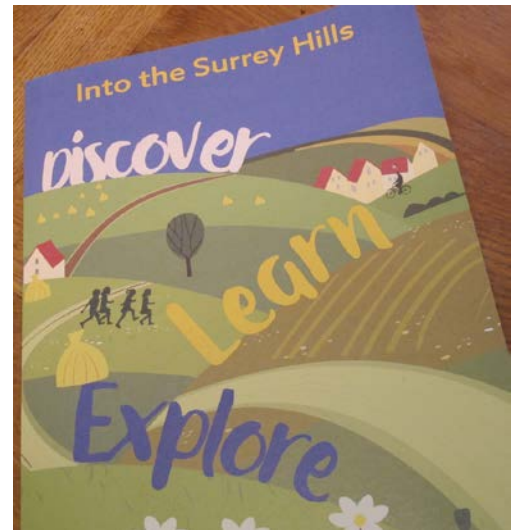
The Surrey Hills Society has sponsored the badge and produced a resource which will give you all the information you need - less work for you the leader! For the price of £1, you get the badge (hope you like it) and the worksheet. To earn the badge, complete the worksheet and some of the suggested activities, and then visit one of the '60 Places to See' on the Surrey Hills website.

It fits perfectly with the new programme - it is a badge the girls could do individually and make the visits with the family. You could do it as a unit - both Faurefold and Heron's Wey are in the AONB so it could be a perfect activity for a residential at either.

Do consider this as a unit or individual activity as we look towards the spring and summer programme and plan to get out and about.
