





Grants for Growth

There are many available grants through Girlguiding that can support growth and the start up of new units:

Grants to Grow:

Only available at certain times.

Awarding £50 vouchers to units in areas of deprivation - Grant to be spent on activities/resources that supports Growth and encourages welcoming new girls into the unit.

Starting a New Unit Grant

Units can receive up to £500 which can go towards start up costs. All new units (and those re-opening after being inactive for 1 year) are eligible.

Trefoil Guild New Unit Grant

A £40 grant (maximum) can be awareded - Helps new units starting out by funding a Girlguiding starter pack.

UK Units in Need Grant

A grant of upto £250 for units that are based in deprived areas, experiencing financial difficulties or who have been affected by a natural disaster.

Accessible Guiding Grant

A grant to help support young members with additional needs access all areas of the Girlguiding programme
