## Update: 1st Response Course Resources

Today's memo is to let you know that we are ready to share our new 1st Response training course and resources with you today. The course will officially launch and be communicated to all members in Making Guiding Happen, during the 1st week of November, but we wanted to make sure you had access to the resources.

Our website has been updated and you should be able to see all of the updates live HERE

Currently, this is the only page on the website to have gone live with changes. Please be patient in case the webpage has not changed straight away, it can sometimes take a while to show for everyone.

Some changes have been made and include:

1. The training has been split into 3 different sections and can be delivered as a full 6-hour course or it can be split into 3 x 2-hour sessions to allow for greater flexibility. 1st Response can be delivered both in-person and virtually using an online platform

The three sessions are:

- Life Support
- Trauma and Injury
- Major Illness
- 2. There will additionally be new e-learning that will need to be completed alongside the training course. This e-learning will cover the Girlguiding specific areas around policies and procedures, accident reporting and care plans. This is a short e-learning that will take around 10-15 minutes to complete
- 3. We have removed the 2-hour refresher course as an option and will require those who wish to renew their 1st Response after 3 years to complete the full course. This decision has been made to maintain the high level of health and safety standards we have at Girlguiding to keep all our members safe.

These changes have allowed us to provide an updated training which considers first aid changes and recommendations during Covid-19 alongside the other changes and updates we wanted to make. We always needed to provide this training virtually for our members, and we wanted to do this with the revised content and produce something that is relevant now and in the future.

An official launch will be coming soon so keep an eye on your e-mails.
