Dear Volunteers in Girlguiding Surrey East,

This will be my last update welcome message as I am passing on the County Commissioner baton to Beverly Heywood-Jones on Friday. I know she is excited to take on the role and I know she will do a fantastic job.

When I think back to autumn 2016 when Lesley Bailey became County Commissioner and I her Assistant County Commissioner, what a lot has happened! We knew change would be the common theme and it's so important we continue to be a fantastic, modern, and relevant positive influence in the lives of the girls and young women we do our guiding for.

We have welcomed in the new programme - not so new anymore! -and got to grips with making it work for our units. The County organised the Girlguiding float for the Lord Mayor's Show in 2016. We were entertained by a host of talented acts in 2017 at Musigals. The Guides went to Scoutabout in 2017 and the Rainbows to Bazzaz in 2018. We represented guiding at The Cenotaph in 2019.

The Faurefold Management Committee finished and opened the holiday house and have been developing the grounds and campsite still more since.

It's been a busy five years! And being County Commissioner is a real honour and privilege. Thank you to the county team for all they have done - past and present people - over the last five years, and thank you to all of you for your week by week commitment to changing the lives of the girls and bringing fun, laughter and adventure to so many young women.
