
- Develop practical skills to build more nature-based sessions into regular programme planning.

#### How to Check your own Record in Go

For those of you who are less familiar with Go (our membership system), you may not know how to check your own details. You will need to log in to the system using your own username and password. There is guidance on the first screen if you have forgotten your username or password. Once you have successfully logged in, you will see your name in the top right hand corner of the screen. If you move the cursor to your name and click, a drop down menu will show options.

To check when your Safe Space modules or First Response expires, select My Achievements. Scroll down to see the Courses and E-Learning. If you did an e-learning, these will expire 3 years after the date completed.

To check when your DBS expires, select My Disclosures. The Valid To date is shown on the screen. You should contact your commissioner or local id verifier to arrange for it to be renewed before it expires.

To check your Emergency Contacts, select My Profile. You can then scroll down to Additional Contacts, where there is an option to Edit your own Emergency Contacts.

#### PGL update

As you may have seen in the media, four PGL sites have had services for non-accompanied children suspended following an Ofsted inspection. Girlguiding's official statement is as follows:

'We work with PGL to offer our young members exclusive adventure weekends at their UK centres. We have been made aware that the regulator Ofsted has suspended PGL programmes for unaccompanied children across four of its centres. Although this does not apply to its activities for accompanied children or uniformed groups, we can confirm that there are no planned Girlguiding visits to these sites for the rest of 2021. We take the safety and wellbeing of all our members seriously and, as with all services used by our members, we will continuously review these partnerships to ensure safeguarding measures are maintained.'

From a safe practice perspective, Girlguiding can't confirm that the sites are unsafe for the services and provision Girlguiding would engage with. Girlguiding are not recommending or asking leaders to cancel accompanied visits to PGL sites, as ever all activities should be risk assessed. If volunteers/parents/carers contact you and need support and guidance where residentials are already booked, rearranged or in plan please contact Volunteer Support.
