Did you know?

Online REN

The residential event notification (REN) should now be completed on Go. The event coordinator should choose the Events option provided on the main menu bar and then use the drop down to Administer Event. For International events this should be 9 – 18 months before the event, and all other residential events, this should be 12 weeks. There is guidance on the system to support you. The request will automatically be passed to the next level commissioner for approval and each member will need to confirm their attendance. It will also help to verify that mandatory qualifications are up to date for the event. There is also a new video walkthrough on completing a REN form as an event organizer **available on YouTube here.**

For a residential adviser to view the online REN, then need to go into 'Adviser/Coordinator' area, select the correct level and go to the Residential Events tab. Here she will see the REN in the bottom table and can use the action arrow to make herself the authorising adviser. It cannot be 'pushed' onto her by someone else.
