I'm sure many of you will be saddened to hear the news that Guiding has proposed to sell its 5 activity centres: Foxlease, Blacklands, Glenbrook, Waddow Hall and Ynysgain (link to the detail here). Many of us have extremely fond memories of times we have spent there over many years, particularly the more local sites and the big events such as Wellies and Wristbands, Magic and Mayhem, Sparkle and Ice. It cannot have been an easy decision. There is still lots to look forward to this summer at the TACS and they are open for bookings for the rest of the year.

Remember, that in our county we have Faurefold and Little Acres and more widely, Heyswood, Heron's Wey, Paxmead and other non-guiding sites that are widely used such as Walton Firs and others too.

Girlguiding hosted two all-members calls this week with chief guide Tracy Foster, chair of the board of trustees Catherine Irwin, and chief executive Angela Salt to explain the rationale for the recent decisions including the announcement to end British Guiding Overseas (BGO). Did you know?

Leadership Qualification transition.

We are in the final stages of transitioning over to the new leadership development programme (LDP) which was introduced last September. The old scheme will be withdrawn completely.

If you currently have a role as assistant leader and have module 4 of the old scheme, we will adjust your role over the summer to be leader. This doesn't affect the role you are doing but will ensure you are aligned to newly qualified leaders who will have the role of leader. Under the new scheme, everyone who completes the LDP will have the role of leader.

If you do not have <u>module 4</u>, you can complete it now, or simply remain an assistant leader without it. If you are a leader in training on the old scheme, time is running out to complete it. Anyone working on the old scheme, that does not complete it by the deadline of end of September, will need to re-register onto the LDP if they would like to become a leader. Early feedback is that people are finding it easier and quicker to complete.

- Photos must be originals that you have taken.
- Young members (under 18) must submit their photos via their leaders or local commissioner to ensure appropriate written consent has been obtained. It is recommended that units select their favourite images to enter one or more of the categories.
- When photographing children and young people under the age of 18, leaders need to get written consent from their parent or carer. This should be noted on their membership record on Go – 'Photos/videos can be shared and published and used for marketing'. Ask the girls as well for their permission when taking photos of them.
- For adult members (18+) obtain their permission too, and ensure they update their membership record on Go as above to given permission for the photo to be shared and published and used for marketing.
- Images should comply with the <u>girlguiding photography principles</u>. They should feel colourful and bright as we're a vibrant youth brand.

We will share the submission form to include links to a secure folder for you to upload your photos next month. The closing date will be Friday 20th October 2023. The winning photos will be used to promote guiding in Surrey East.
