A leader with safe space 3 is required at all meetings, events and activities. Please do sign up above if you haven't done one before. A renewal e-learning is now available on the learning development platform. It is recommended that all leaders complete safe space 3.

## Did you know?

#### Registering Rangers, young leaders, young external volunteers and peer educators

We see some people struggle with setting up young leaders in Go so they can then go on to complete their safe space training on the leadership development platform without issues – particularly when they are moving up from Guides.

Here are the key steps:

- 1. Parent/carer needs to complete a New Starter form: 14-17- Rangers, young leaders, young external volunteers and peer educators.
- 2. Commissioner then locates their account via their membership number and adds them as a volunteer. **Ensure the young member has their own email address on their GO record.**
- 3. Young volunteer then needs to request an invitation code from the GO log in page by clicking 'Don't have a log in?' button.
- 4. Then, they need to redeem the invitation to access Go and create a username for GO (they must ensure that this is unique to them so we suggest avoiding using names as we can have many members with the same/similar names).
- 5. They need to wait 24 hours before heading to the learning platform.
- 6. Then on the Learning platform they need to enter the same GO username they created and click 'forgotten password?' to be issued. They can then log in to the learning platform and change the password to one of their own choosing and complete their Safe Space training.

## County Outdoor Day - Sunday 24th September 9.30-3.30 at Faurefold - Open to all volunteers!

Outdoor County day will be a fantastic opportunity to spend time at Faurefold learning new crafts, skills and ideas. It is open to all volunteers in girlguiding Surrey East including leaders, young leaders and unit helpers.

Drinks and snacks will be available - If possible, please bring your own mug and let us know about any allergies or dietary restrictions we may need to be aware of.

## Session one is a choice of:

-Low ropes Team Challenge- Leader briefing and entry into a team competition. - A chance to learn how to take your girls on the low rope challenge course at Faurefold, followed by a friendly timed competition to complete the course quicker than your guiding friends.

-**Basic Fire lighting** including unit meeting activities (UMAs) and skills builders for all sections. - Perfect for rainbow and brownie leaders and less experienced guide leaders, who would like the gain the confidence to complete some of the 'have adventures' programme.

-**Indoor training-** Promote units though social media- including setting up Twitter etc/ rules Facebook pages and using social media and good photos (taking and management / storage)

Please bring your own lunch for a long lunch break with chance to socialise with other leaders, verify your identity for your DBS, if required, find out about become a leadership mentor, visit the volunteer shop (pre order available), try the trails and orienteering at Faurefold, attend a campfire sing song.

-Basic Map reading/ Basic navigation- the opportunity to learn some basic map reading skills and take some skills and ideas back to your unit.

-**Low ropes Team Challenge-** Leader briefing and entry into a team competition. A chance to learn how to take your girls on the low rope challenge course at Faurefold, followed by a friendly timed competition to complete the course quicker than your guiding friends.

-Intermediate fire lighting and cooking - with links to your section UMAs and skills builders

The beautiful lodge at our campsite in the grounds of Horton Country Park, Epsom has finally been completed. It comprises a large hall for sleepovers, a leaders' room, toilets and shower,

kitchen and large veranda running round two sides of the building. There is full disabled access.

The campsite itself offers a huge camping area with campfire , wood store, concrete bases for smaller fires, outside tap and power in a quiet private area in the picturesque and peaceful setting of the county park. There is also plenty of camping equipment and other useful items like pond dipping nets available to borrow free of charge.

Horton Country Park itself is a beautiful area for walks and there is an equestrian centre to book riding, Hobbledown Adventure Park and Horton Golf Club there.

## Rules:

- Open to units and all members and recognised volunteers in girlguiding Surrey East.
- Photos must be originals that you have taken.
- Young members (under 18) must submit their photos via their leaders or local commissioner to ensure appropriate written consent has been obtained. It is recommended that units select their favourite images to enter one or more of the categories.
- When photographing children and young people under the age of 18, leaders need to get written consent from their parent or carer. This should be noted on their membership record on Go – 'Photos/videos can be shared and published and used for marketing'. Ask the girls as well for their permission when taking photos of them.
- For adult members (18+) obtain their permission too, and ensure they update their membership record on Go as above to given permission for the photo to be shared and published and used for marketing.
- Images should comply with the *girlguiding photography principles*. They should feel colourful and bright as we're a vibrant youth brand.

We will share the submission form to include links to a secure folder for you to upload your photos next month. The closing date will be Friday 20<sup>th</sup> October 2023. The winning photos will be used to promote guiding in Surrey East.
