A leader with safe space 3 is required at all meetings, events and activities. It is recommended that all leaders complete safe space 3. A renewal e-learning is now available on the learning development platform for anyone who has a current safe space 3 due for renewal. Once it has expired, you will need to sign up for the webinar or a face-to-face safe space 3 training.

Our Leaders weekend, open to all volunteers in Surrey East county will be held at Pax Lodge – our Guiding World Centre based in London. The dates are Friday 18th October – Sunday 20th October 2024.

The accommodation cost is £38 per person per night plus £3 per head badge pinning ceremony (a unique opportunity to receive this badge only given in the World Centres). There may be additional costs for activities we choose to do which will include an all-day treasure hunt.

Rules:

- Open to units and all members and recognised volunteers in girlguiding Surrey East.
- Photos must be originals that you have taken.
- Young members (under 18) must submit their photos via their leaders or local commissioner to ensure appropriate written consent has been obtained. It is recommended that units select their favourite images to enter one or more of the categories.
- When photographing children and young people under the age of 18, leaders need to get written consent from their parent or carer. This should be noted on their membership record on Go – 'Photos/videos can be shared and published and used for marketing'. Ask the girls as well for their permission when taking photos of them.
- For adult members (18+) obtain their permission too, and ensure they update their membership record on Go as above to given permission for the photo to be shared and published and used for marketing.
- Images should comply with the *girlguiding photography principles*. They should feel colourful and bright as we're a vibrant youth brand.

Please submit your entries via the <u>Photography submission form</u>. The final closing date will be **Friday 15th December 2023**. The winning photos will be used to promote guiding in Surrey East.
