#### <u>Safe Space modules/Safer Guiding :</u>

Safe Space modules 1,2,3 is being replaced with 'Safer Guiding'. This new 3-hour e-learning covers data protection, safeguarding, inclusion and health and safety in one and will be available via the learning platform from 4<sup>th</sup> December.

It's important for you to continue to renew your current safe space levels if you have received a reminder to do so before this date. Your renewal date will be extended by 3 years and whatever is your highest level will become the renewal date for Safer Guiding. Thereafter all girl-facing roles will be required to do the Safer Guiding e-learning and there will be a safer guiding basics course for all those who don't have contact with girls, for example an ID verifier.

## Did you know?

#### Trustees

In Guiding we are all trustees of our units and follow the guiding code of conduct and supporting policies to ensure we are compliant with charity law. Some of you are also trustees of a guiding charity (typically where the local area owns or leases property). In this case, are you have responsibilities to the charity commission and to girlguiding.
