Safer Guiding:

This new 3-hour e-learning covers data protection, safeguarding, inclusion and health and safety in one. It's divided into topics and is designed for you to dip in and out of. For those that prefer a trainerled session, there will be webinar or face-to-face options available for you to book on the learning platform. You don't need to do the training until your highest level of a safe space is due to expire but you're welcome to complete it at any time before then if you wish.

Safer guiding basics is a shorter course specifically for a limited number of volunteers who do not work directly with girls.
