Assistant Leader Roles

We are planning to update the role type for volunteers who have 'assistant leader' roles but already have the old leader qualification module 4. The role of assistant leader was withdrawn so all leaders who complete the new leader development programme (LDP) are now assigned a role type of 'leader'. This change does not affect the local agreements you have for current leadership roles and responsibilities.

This also does not affect people who don't have the LQ module 4 and wish to remain Assistant Leader however please be warned this may result in issues if you change units or become non-compliant as the role can only be assigned by membership systems. Existing Assistant leaders are welcome to complete the [LDP top-up module](#) on the learning platform to become Leaders too if they wish.

Trooping the Colour 2026 (Kings Birthday Parade)



I'm delighted to share that Surrey East has been offered 30 places to attend this year's [Trooping the Colour](#) 2026 (Kings Birthday Parade) on Saturday 13 June 2026. We're sure this is an opportunity many units would like to take up, so we have setup a ballot to enable you to apply for your unit, or to apply on behalf of two local units together as a group.

We need a group main contact to complete the application form and if selected be the main contact to lead the group. The group itself must be a maximum of 30 people (young members and their leaders, in ratio (ie no more adults than needed)).

The event is open to all sections but please note that the Youth Enclosure is a standing area and, as space is limited, people will not be allowed to bring camping chairs or seating with them. Ground sheets are allowed if people wish to sit on the ground. Units would need to be at the entry point to the Youth Enclosure for around 8am and any units not arrived by 10:00am will not be allowed access as it will interfere with the parade. The organising team expect that the event will be finished by about 1pm.

All participants will need to wear smart uniform and have active roles on Go. Attending adults must have enhanced DBS checks and be able to provide valid photo ID on arrival at the event. Participating units would need to arrange and fund their own travel.

The lucky group will be confirmed by the county commissioner who will need to confirm the main contact and the names and email addresses for all adults attending the event and the total number of young members by section and any accessibility/welfare requirements on the day by 9 March. There is a small chance we may be offered some additional tickets so we will select a backup group too.
